DIRECTIONS FROM INTERSTATE 70: Take Route 61 North. Go North for about 15 miles. Exit at Route 47 West. Go about 2.3 miles and turn right onto Highway H. Go about 7 miles on Highway H. Turn left onto Tagg Road (gravel road) just before the sign advertising the Kinion Cemetery. Take the gravel road about a mile to the stone house with silver silos and follow the road to the right for about another half mile. This road ends at the gate to the Eastern Missouri Beagle Club.

ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 per entry for all stakes. No charge for Absolute Run. **Make checks payable to DCSTL for Friday, Saturday and Sunday.** Be sure to bring your dogs' entry information with you. RUNNING ORDER: Classes will run consecutively with OAAD followed by OAAB & then combined FC, and Absolute. Be prepared for this running order. Judges will not wait for dogs except as provided for in AKC rules. The committee reserves the right to make changes as needed to expedite the event.

TRACKING COLLARS AND/OR HARNESES: The use of tracking collars **will not** be allowed at these trials. The AKC rules are silent regarding use of body harnesses. As a result, body harnesses will only be allowed if the handler receives advance permission of both judges for the class. The harness must be well fitting with nothing hanging from it and with no attachments other than tag for identification purposes. If permitted to wear a harness, it must remain on the dog the entire time the dog is under judgment.

COVID REQUIREMENTS: Please read!!

Please do not attend these trials if you have:

1. A fever, cough or flu-like symptoms
2. Tested positive for COVID-19 and have not been free of fever without fever-suppressing medication for 10 days
3. Traveled internationally in the past month
4. Been in direct contact with someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days.

All participants, spectators, other attendees will be required to sign a COVID waiver attesting to the above and agreeing to follow any and all health requirements.

A copy of the waiver form is attached and will be posted on the DCSTL web-site

Please print and sign prior to arrival.

Wrist bands will be issued to be worn throughout all events.

To the extent applicable, these trials will comply with State of Missouri and Lincoln County Executive Orders and Ordinances, Private Campground Guidelines, and guidance provided by the American Kennel Club.

NOTE: The clubhouse will only be available to a limited number of people at one time (IAW guidance current guidance during the trials) and only for essential tasks (restroom, shower, picking up meals, etc.) After using the shower, everyone will be required to spray the shower with disinfectant (provided) and remove all personal items after use. This includes wet towels. Shower can be used during the hours of 7PM thru 6AM. Please be courteous and keep your time in the shower/restroom to no more than 20 minutes. No congregating in the clubhouse.

Everyone must wear mask while in clubhouse.

- Please be prepared for weather and bring your own chairs as well as you own pens and pencils. If you take a pencil do NOT return it.
- Roll call and bracing will be held outside to allow social distancing.

SOCIAL DISTANCING
